

Dear Club Captain,

Please see below the draw for the qualifying rounds for the CompassSport Cup 2022. It has not been possible to allocate all clubs to their preferred options because of the entry constraints of the hosting clubs. If you decide that your club does not wish to compete, please advise me as soon as practical so I can advise the hosting clubs. By way of explanation the estimated entry number for the seven events excluding Scotland is 2,100 which means on average each of the seven qualifying events needs to take at least 300 entrants. For 2022 some events can take this number, some less and a few more. By default, clubs should enter their Association round. Redistribution of clubs is implemented when an event cannot take all the clubs from their Association/s and the need to create viable events. It is appreciated that this will not suit all clubs and create some long journeys. I have made the best possible fit having consulted with all the event organisers over event capacity.
